Dr. Bizri is a consultant in Internal Medicine and Infectious Diseases at the American University of Beirut Medical Center (AUBMC), Associate Chairperson for Clinical Affairs, and Director of Quality and Compliance Program at the Department of Internal Medicine. Dr. Bizri is an Affiliate of the Conflict Medicine Program at AUB. Served as the chairperson of the Infection Control Program and Infection Control Committee at AUBMC till 2005 and established many infection control programs in various teaching medical centers in both the private and public sectors. Has numerous publications on antibiotic resistance, and the changing epidemiology of infectious diseases mainly Salmonella, rabies, viral hepatitis, HIV/AIDS, invasive mycosis, microbiology of war related infections, and refugee medicine. Dr. Bizri has written many chapters in Internal Medicine and Infectious Diseases textbooks. He is a member of the editorial board of several international and regional journals. Participated and presented in numerous international meetings and serves as a WHO expert and advisor on infectious and transmissible diseases. Dr. Bizri has special interest in infections in conflict situation and viral hepatitis. Produced a number of manuscripts about the impact of the Syrian war on infectious diseases in Lebanon and the region.
